Reporting Group B Offenses



- Group B crime categories are arrest-only offenses that are not considered Group A offenses.
- A separate Group B arrest report should be submitted for each arrestee associated with the Group B offense.
- If an arrest for a Group B offense leads to the clearance of a previously submitted Group A
 Incident Report, the reporting agency should submit an Arrestee
 Segment as an update to the initial
 Group A Incident Report.
