Availability of Automated License Plate Reader System Registration Forms

TO: All Washington State and Local Agencies Operating or Intending to Operate Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) Systems

FROM: Washington State Attorney General's Office

RE: Registration of ALPR Systems Under ESSB 6002, Chapter 239, Laws of 2026

DATE: June 24, 2026

Section 3(5) of ESSB 6002 (Chapter 239, Laws of 2026) (the Act), requires every agency that currently uses, or intends to use, an automated license plate reader (ALPR) system to register that system with the Attorney General's Office (AGO). The AGO is required to approve registration forms within 180 days of the effective date of the Act. Agencies may not access, operate, or use an ALPR system that has not been properly registered in accordance with Section 3(5) of the Act.

Registration Forms Now Available

The AGO has approved the required registration form and is making it available to all state and local agencies through a secure online web form. Agencies that have notified the AGO of their intent to register their ALPR systems must complete this form to comply with the Act's registration requirements. A. Registration Requirements

In completing the online registration form, the head of each agency must certify that:

1. The agency's ALPR system meets all requirements of the Act;
2. The agency has adopted a policy or policies governing the use of its ALPR system; and
3. The agency has a documented training process for officers and personnel who will use the system.

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Deadline

There is no fixed deadline to register an ALPR system. The AGO interprets Section 3(5) of the Act as requiring the AGO to provide approved registration forms within 180 days of the Act's effective date, and not as setting a 180 day deadline for registration.
